Crisp cool whites set the tone, while small doses of orange and green are brought in as fun contrasting accents. The streamlined white slipper chairs are brought to life with whimsical square orange throw pillows offering an abundance of texture and colorful eye candy.

Two mirrored cube end tables sit one right in front of the other as "his & hers" tables (I'm a big believer that every chair needs a table!) while also offering a reflective property in keeping with our light airy ambiance. Flowing white sheers were hung from a rich
